It is not unusual for people who travel away from home to need medical attention. And when that medical attention is major, you have to decide if you or your loved ones stay at that distant medical facility or pay to be transported to a medical facility that is close to home.

In a recent post, one of our member's father suffered a massive heart attack when in Mexico. He was transferred from a medical facility on the Pacific Coast to Mexico City where he passed away. His remains were transferred from Mexico City back into the states. The total cost for transportation was in excess of US\$40,000 dollars. In retrospect, if the family had a medical evacuation program such as MedJet, the total cost, on an annual basis, would have been less than \$350 dollars, a savings in this case of about \$39,650 dollars.

The BBP has looked at about four different programs that are available to groups such as ours and has decided to make MedJet available to our members. There are few limitations other than the transfer has to be from the place of injury (conditions apply) to a hospital and / or from a hospital to a different hospital, almost anywhere in the world.

Personally, for only \$365 per year for my family, it was a no brainier. I signed Karaen and I up and in addition, signed up Kim and her family and Claudia and her family. Now when we travel anywhere be it in the states or across a border, we know that if there is a medical emergency, we have a choice....
